ACTIVITIES' REPORT

The Publications Committee has been very active throughout the year. Much of the work is done by MUFAP's editorial team consisting of Zulfiqar Azam and Shafaq Khurram and the Committee reviews the material before printing or hosting it on the website. The main objective of the Publications Committee is to ensure that MUFAP publications become the authentic documents of industry data and information and is used by investors and others as the source of information about the mutual fund industry.

1. MUFAP Yearbook

The Committee published its second Yearbook for the year 2011 and is currently working on the Yearbook for 2012

which is expected to be published shortly. The Yearbook provides information regarding the developments in the industry, capital markets and on the regulatory front. Statistics on the mutual funds industry are part of the publication to provide the first hand industry information to the readers. The Yearbook is distributed to all members of MUFAP, Senate, National Assembly, Federal Board of Revenue, State Bank of Pakistan, Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan, Stock Exchanges, Competition Commission, Planning Commission, NCCPL, Trustees, Banks, Audit Firms, Listed and other large companies, International Associations, Business Schools, Hospitals, Welfare Organizations and Clubs etc.

2. MUFAP Quarterly Newsletter

During the year, MUFAP published four newsletters, one every quarter. The newsletter contains updates on the industry and capital markets. Activities of MUFAP and its members are also highlighted. Articles contributed by members consist of topics ranging from public awareness to various innovate investment products. Quarterly statistics are also part of the publication.

3. Other activities
